LandSouth looks to improve business and community

LandSouth Construction's President and CEO James G. Pyle's mission is not only to be successful, but significant.

"[Pyle] is the backbone of this company," said Mike Taylor, the director of business development and senior project manager. "In today's marketplace, it's always about getting the bottom line, but he makes sure that we're taking care of the

community."

Since the company was founded 11 years ago, LandSouth's 27 employees have built more than 6,000 multifamily units, which house about 17,000 people.

LandSouth Construction employees volunteer for several organizations such as Habitat for Humanity, Habitat for Humanity Jax and Builders Care, where they build projects and homes for those in need. They've also

organized a team for breast cancer walks and participated in organizations such as the Cystic Fibrosis Foundation and the Monique Burr

Foundation for Children.

But no matter what they are doing, the workplace environment alone makes LandSouth a great place to work, according to Kimberly Johnston, the company's office manager.
